The Prep Baseball Report's Unsigned Senior Showcase on Oct. 18 featured a strong group of Class of 2010 prospects. There were several standout performances at the Max-McCook Athletic & Exposition Center. A look at some of the top players at the event:

Jacob Rone, RHP/INF, Downers Grove South HS: The 6-foot-3, 175-pound Rone is a long and wiry pitcher with a loose arm. His fastball sat in the mid-80s with run, topping at 86 mph. He has good extension and hand speed with his splitter that has late depth. His slider was also impressive with a two-plane break.

Dan Walsh, SS, Downers Grove South HS: The left-handed hitting Walsh proved that he is one of the best uncommitted middle infielders in the state. The 6-foot-2, 175-pounder has excellent hands and a solid arm at shortstop, and can really swing it from the left side.

Steve Danielak, OF, Hersey HS: Danielak was clearly the top outfield prospect at the event. The 6-foot-4, 205-pounder showcased a plus arm from the outfield, firing 88-mph strikes to third base. Equally as impressive, the left-handed hitting Danielak showed big power potential as he drove the ball to all fields with authority. Danielak, who is also a strong student, ran a 7.4 60.

Jacob Butler, RHP/MIF, Minooka HS: The 6-foot-3, 190-pound Butler has a long, lean pitcher's build with a whippy arm and fast hand. His fastball, which touched 85, is delivered from a steep downhill plane and has some run. He also threw a tight late-breaking curveball with depth. He also displayed the ability to drive the ball at the plate.

Scott Vachon, Plainfield North HS, RHP/OF: A monstrous presence, the 6-foot-6, 235-pound Vachon is coming off a knee injury that sidelined him this spring and summer. Although he is just working his way back into playing shape, Vachon was impressive. His fastball sat at 85 mph with some late life.

Brandon Shaw, RHP/SS, North Fulton HS: Shaw was one of the hardest throwers at the event, consistently touching 85 with his fastball. He has a quick arm and good hand acceleration, which allows him to create some arm side movement. His changeup was down in the zone and had late fade.

Jimmy Spagna, 3B/RHP, Carmel Catholic HS: A two-way talent, Spagna showed equally well at third base as he did on the mound. Spagna was one of the top defensive infielders at the event, and showed gap power at the plate. On the mound, he displayed a quick arm, touching 84 mph with his fastball with more in the tank. He also flashed a good change with late fade.

Mike Pudlo, MIF, Carmel Catholic HS: A top-level defensive middle infielder, Pudlo possesses an extremely quick transfer, soft hands and moves well laterally. Offensively, Pudlo showed to have a compact, line-drive producing swing and he ran a 7.11 60.

Corey Lasky, OF, Stevenson HS: The 5-foot-7, left-handed hitter was the top athlete at the event, as Lasky ran a 6.89 60. Lasky is a top-level defensive outfielder, as he moves fluidly and showed impressive defensive instincts along with an accurate arm that topped at 81 mph. At the plate, he possesses a quick, compact swing and drives the ball to all fields.

Cory Johnson, OF, Oswego HS: Johnson is one of the bigger sleepers in the class, as the 5-foot-11, 170-pound left-handed hitting outfielder showed he can do just about everything on the field well. A 7.0 runner, Johnson showcased a strong arm from the outfield

(85 mph) with excellent carry. At the plate, he allows the ball to travel deep in the zone and uses his quick hands and compact swing to produce line drives to all fields.

Andrew Godbold, OF/1B, Oak Park-River Forest HS: At 6-foot-3 and a muscular 210 pounds, Godbold is an athletically built specimen who possesses raw natural power and quick hands at the plate. A versatile defender, he showed well in the outfield and at first base, where he demonstrated soft hands and good footwork. Also a standout basketball player.

Matt Risdon, Catcher, Mundelein HS: One of the better receivers in the Class of 2010, Risdon possesses extraordinarily soft hands behind the plate and is an exemplary blocker. Offensively, the 5-foot-8, 170-pound Risdon showed a compact, balanced swing with good hitting mechanics.

Jordan Fortner, 1B/3B/C/RHP, Mt. Zion HS: The 6-foot-4, 200-pound Fortner showed he can play several positions well, as he was well versed at the corner infield positions and featured arm strength behind the dish. At the plate, he displayed pull power from the right side. Fortner was one of the top hitters at the event.

Louis Whittier, OF, Proviso West HS: Whittier is an athletically built 6-foot-1 outfielder who moves fluidly in the outfield to go along with a solid arm (81 mph). Offensively, he showed impressive bat speed and a balanced swing.

Ricky Janokowicz, 2B/OF/RHP, Glenbard North HS: Janokowicz showed he can play both the outfield and infield adeptly, as he moves fluidly and has solid carry on his throws (80 mph). He is an aggressive hitter who ran a 7.22 60.

Merrick McGrady, RHP, Stevenson HS: McGrady showcased the ability to throw three pitches for strikes. He possesses a quick arm and touched 81 on the mound. His change-up had some late life and was his best pitch. Also ran a 7.16 60.

Hugh Berglind, Riverside-Brookfield, RHP/1B: The 6-5, 270-pound Berglind is an imposing presence on the mound. He has clean mechanics with good extension, and showed the ability to repeat his delivery. Berglind's best pitch was a tight breaking curveball. He touched 83 with his fastball and also threw a change.

Eric Sowa, Joliet West HS, RHP/2B: A strike-thrower, the Joliet West product showed clean mechanics on the mound and touched 80 mph with his fastball and threw his curveball for strikes.

Joey Igyarto, St. Patrick, OF/RHP: On the mound, Igyarto showcased the ability to throw three pitches for strikes. His fastball touched 81 with some life. In the outfield, he moves athletically with a solid arm. Ran a 7.16 60.

Jake Murphy, Plainfield Central, RHP/OF: The 6-foot-1 Murphy has a projectable frame and a loose arm. He touched 80 on the mound with a good change-up. Murphy also showed to be a solid outfielder.

Jim Hermle, INF, Lincoln-Way North HS: Hermle is a powerfully built 5-foot-9, 190-pound infielder who has a solid arm across the infield (80 mph).

Jacob Mijares, Nazareth, RHP/3B: Mijares has a solid build and quick motion. He touched 81 on the mound and flashed an above average change with run.
